Surface Water Scheme under AMRUT

Our Municipality have already submitted to KMDA of value Rs 2,57.05 Crore. It is expected that it will be placed in State Level Meeting on 10.12.2016.

Proposal of this surface water scheme is as following: Surface Water will be lifted from river Ganga and will be delivered to the proposed water treatment plant at Laskarpur.

Under Ground Reservoirs

In this scheme total Rajpur-Sonarpur Municipality area has been divided in to 23 no separate zones. Each zone will have a dedicated ERS to serve the population of the respective zone. There is one (1) number existing UGR (At Ward No. 31) , another 3 nos UGRs is given proposed to pump the clear water to the ERSs.) . Zone wise division according to UGR is given in DAG No. JB/KMDA/RSM-02 Vol.2 of this DPR. UGRs will be designed as per IS: 3370 latest version and will be constructed with pile foundation.

HOUSING FOR ALL

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) aims that, providing housing for all by 2022 when the nation complete 75 years of its independence. The people of the municipality, the elected Councillors, the staff members, the surveyors, the technical persons have extended their fullest cooperation in preparing the whole process of *Housing for All DPR*, for year of 2015-16. Out of 178 slums, 44 nos of slums and its 1334 nos. beneficiaries are selected for the “Beneficiary led Construction” scheme for this financial year. The total sanction amount is Rs.5400.03 lakh as per relevant dept & P.W.D schedule rates. The infrastructural expenditure for the year of 2015-16, 490.91lakh.

The total project cost is distributed among Govt Of India, Govt Of West Bengal, ULB and individual beneficiary.

Repairing & Renovation of Parks under Rajpur-Sonarpur Municipality

Some of the parks are going to be repaired and renovated under Rajpur-Sonarpur Municipality under AMRUT Scheme this year. Those are:

1. Srinagar Giribala School Park (Ward-1)-Estimated Cost Rs. 8.96 Lakh
2. Mission Pally Park (Ward-8)- Estimated Cost Rs. 9.26 Lakh
3. Bidya Bhusan Park (Ward-19)- Estimated Cost Rs. 9.64 Lakh
4. Garia Place Park (Ward-29)- Estimated Cost Rs. 7.20 Lakh
5. Srikrishna Pally/ Mohini Pally (Ward-32)- Estimated Cost Rs. 14.98Lakh

As these parks are old, there are plenty of scopes for renovation and repairing. Some of the examples that are to be added in these parks are: Paved Pathways, Water areas, Eating & Drinking Facilities, Boundary Walls, Landscaping, Sitting or resting features etc. The pictures of these parks are being attached followed.



As we can see from these pictures, the present condition of these parks is not very well. So, these are going to be renovated into a modern age parks with new age infrastructures and facilities. The work will be started very soon.

Inauguration of Solar System at Sonarpur Local Office Rooftop

The new Solar power Generating System will be inaugurated on 10th Feb, 2016 in our Municipality at the rooftop of Sonarpur Local Office. Honorable Minister in Charge Mr Shri Manish Gupta, Minister-in-charge, Department of Power & Non Conventional Energy Sources, Govt. of West Bengal along with 2 MLAs, Chairman of Rajpur-Sonarpur Municipality Dr. Pallab Das, Vice Chairman Smt Santa Sarkar and all the 5 CIC members will be present during the inauguration program. It is a on grid Solar Connection System, which is a non conventional energy source. The energy source is one of its kind in this area. It is the first step in getting self sufficient in case of energy and this type of non conventional, environment friendly energy sources are to be encouraged for pollution free surroundings. Another advantage of this new system is that, the generated power will go to the distribution like of WBSEDCL through net metering system. This will reduce the cost of electricity.
